










How to Separate and Dispose of Garbage

Yachiyo Town

- Find your designated waste collection site (ask your land agent, neighbors, etc.) Please do not use another site. If there is anything unclear, please contact the Environmental Measures Section, Town of Yachiyo Office.
- Be sure to dispose of garbage at your designated waste collection site by 8:00 a.m. on the collection day.
- Follow the rules of the collection day, time, site and categories. Illegal garbage disposal is punishable by law.

Burnable Garbage	 Put in designated bags (with Red Letters)	 Kitchen Waste Plastic Waste paper	Every Monday and Thursday	Designated Waste Collection Site of Your neighborhood {Find your designated waste collection site for your house/ apartment (ask your land agent, neighbors, etc.) Please do not use another site.}	Drain off liquid from wet food waste. Items that do not fit into a designated bag are regarded as oversized garbage.
Non-burnable Garbage	 Put in designated bags (with Blue Letters)	 Metals Glass Ceramics Sprays	Every Saturday		Empty spray cans and Pierce them outdoors. Items that do not fit into a designated bag are regarded as oversized garbage.
Recyclables	The designated collection site	 Cans Magazines Newspapers Cardboard	Once a Month	If you have any questions, please contact the Environmental Measures Section, Town of Yachiyo Office. (Phone: 0296-48-3818)	Rinse the inside of cans. Tie into a bundle with string according to the type of the items. (magazines, newspapers, and cardboard)
		 Plastic PET Bottles marked with  Bottles	Twice a Month		Rinse the inside. Remove lids and labels of plastic bottles. Separate bottles by the color.
Hazardous Waste/Items	Put into the designated collection container at the collection site	 Batteries, Fluorescent lights, Mercury thermometers	Once a Month		Don't put broken fluorescent lights into the container.
Oversized Garbage	Bring directly to Clean port Kinu (クリーンポート・きぬ)	 Bicycles Bedclothes Furniture	Open: Monday to Friday Time: 9:00 a.m.-11:45 p.m. 1:00 p.m.- 4:30 p.m.	Bring directly to Clean port Kinu (クリーンポート・きぬ)	If you cannot bring items directly, please contact the Environmental Measures Section, Town of Yachiyo. Phone: 0296-48-3818

※ **Items Yachiyo Town Does Not Collect** (Do not dispose of the below items either at the collection site or Clean Port Kinu.)

- Automobile Parts(tires, wheels, batteries, seats, etc.), agricultural chemicals, paints, concrete blocks, stones, sand, ashes, fire extinguishers, etc.
- Business-related waste, industrial waste, construction waste, etc.
- Four Electrical Appliances (TVs, Air conditioners, Electric Refrigerators/Freezers, and Laundry Machines/Clothes Dryers) are collected by appliance stores in principle, in accordance with the Electric Appliance Recycling Law, For disposal of Used Personal Computers including the hardware and monitors, please check the website of the manufacturer or the PC 3R Promotion Center (Phone: 03-5282-7685).
Recycling and transportation fees will apply to each item.
